Dear Western Technology Center Patrons,

We know that our community families may travel extensively over Spring Break. With the health and well-being of our schools and the community in mind, if you are traveling internationally, please be aware of where you are in relation to Coronavirus/COVID 19 hotspots. Conditions relative to the virus are changing daily and may have a significant impact on your ability to return to the U.S. and for students (children and adults), clients, and WTC staff to immediately return to school and classes.

At this time, if a student, client, and/or WTC staff member travels to and returns from a country, region or state that the Center for Disease Control (CDC) has designated Level 3 before or during your stay there, they will be asked to self-quarantine for 14 days upon returning. After the 14-day period, if symptom-free, they will be allowed to return to school. Currently, China, Iran, Europe, South Korea, and Japan are on the list of countries. If you are traveling, please continue to monitor the CDC website or news outlets for additional countries as they may be added.
