Aisle, back up warning alarm, battery, bumper, crossing control arm, defroster, door/service, driver's seatbelt, emergency exits, emergency equipment, floors, heaters and hoses, steering mechanism, suspension, frame, tiers, wheels and rims, horn, lettering, interior, lamps and signals, mirrors, seat covers and crash barriers, stop arm signal, interior sun shield, wiring, specially equipped busses, windshield, and other glass.

Students should bring pencil/pen and paper. Students will be evaluated Pass/Fail on both the written test and the hands-on inspection of a bus with known problems.
